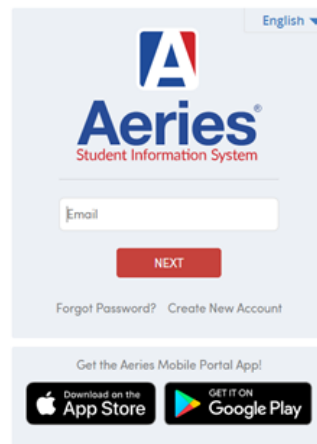

- Summer school courses will be offered in person. Distance Learning option will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis (not guaranteed). Students will need access to the internet. Please note that devices will be available to students who need one.
- Students will not be admitted to summer school after **June 16, 2021.**

Please note that your summer school grade does not replace any failing grade earned during the regular school year; it will however be printed on your transcript as a separate summer school grade. The summer school course allows you to earn credit to meet specific graduation requirements or earn a better grade to meet the A-G requirements.



Eligibility

HIGH SCHOOL:

- Be a current senior at Greenfield High School
- Plan of pursuing Higher Education (Community College, CSU, UC, Private University, Technical/Vocational Program)
- **NO GPA** requirement
- **NO LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION** required
- Two 250 word responses

COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

- Must be a current undergraduate student at a local community college in Monterey County who:
 - Will continue to be enrolled as a full-time community college student during the fall quarter/semester of the 2021/2022 academic year
- OR**
- Must be a soon-to-be community college graduate from a local community college in Monterey County who:
 - Will complete their last classes of community college during the 2021 Spring or Summer quarter/semester **and**;
 - Will transfer to and attend a four-year college for the 2021/2022 academic year (**four-year college does not have to be in Monterey County*)
- Copy of your resume
- One Letter of Recommendation (high school teacher, advisor, university faculty, job/club/program supervisor, community leader or other appropriate professional)
